CARE & MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

All Mincey cast marble products are non-porous and groutless, making them easy to clean and maintain.
No mold and mildew. No regrouting or resealing. **EVER.**

With proper care, our showers stay looking like new - year after year.

ROUTINE CLEANING

Purpose: for regular cleanings

For everyday cleaning, simply use a daily shower cleaner on your panels and pans. Refer to your cleaning supplier for recommendations. We have not seen negative effects from using any regular tub or shower cleaner on our products. After cleaning, be sure to rinse the shower completely. Products can accumulate on pan, causing slipperiness.

SPOT CLEANING - SHOWER PANS

Purpose: for stubborn stains

Our cast marble is non-porous and repels stains, but guests or residents may leave a stubborn spot behind. Since you probably won't know what caused the stain, different kinds of cleaning chemicals may be required.

First Option:

1. Spray an industrial strength degreaser on the pan's surface (ex: Purple Power™).
2. Then lightly dust with a scouring agent (ex: Bar Keepers Friend™).
3. Scrub the surface with a nylon brush.
4. Thoroughly rinse the surface to remove all cleaning agents and residue.

Second Option:

1. Apply lacquer thinner to the stain.
2. Scrub with a nylon brush.

NOTE: We do not recommend these methods for daily cleaning. This process is to be used periodically to remove stains and residues.

DEEP CLEANING - SHOWER PANS

Purpose: for dingy or slippery pans

A deep cleaning is recommended if your pans start to get dingy or slippery. This is often due to buildup from cleaning products and toiletries.

If you're addressing slipperiness, try this cleaning method on only half of the pan first. Test the results by stepping into the pan barefoot, before and after cleaning. This simple test will help you feel the improvement firsthand.

Get your Mincey pans looking and feeling like new:

1. Spray an industrial strength degreaser on the pan's surface (ex: Purple Power™).
2. Then, lightly dust with a scouring agent (ex: Bar Keepers Friend™).
3. Scrub the surface of the pan with a nylon brush.
4. Rinse the surface with plenty of water to ensure all cleaning agents and residue are completely removed.

NOTE: We do not recommend this method for daily cleaning. This process is to be used periodically to remove stains and residues.

REPAIRS

Purpose: cracks or chips

Although our cast marble is highly impact and scratch resistant, sharp objects could damage the finish, resulting in the need for repair. If your product gets chipped, request a repair kit. Follow the instructions included.
