

Container Shipment Delivery Information

Container shipments are reserved for projects located in areas that can only be reached by vessel/boat instead of highways – typically Alaska and Hawaii. Our ocean carrier is equipped to handle any inland transportation moves needed to deliver your freight once it arrives to the local port, or you may arrange the pick-up and return of the container with your own third party carrier.

Once Mincey Marble has produced the order and the material is ready for shipment, we will load a container and our carrier will drive it to the local railyard to travel by train to the closest mainland port. Once the container is loaded onto the vessel, it will travel by sea to the port nearest to the project's location. You will then be notified that the container is available at port and either set up the delivery through our carrier or arrange the pick-up with your preferred carrier directly.

A 5,000 lb capacity forklift with **minimum** 72" forks and a pallet jack is required to be onsite to offload material upon delivery.
