

Partial / Oversized Shipment Delivery Information

When Mincey Marble has produced your order and it is ready for shipment, if the order was packaged in a small or medium sized crate, it will ship as a partial load on a flatbed or enclosed van. This is very beneficial as the shipment will go direct from Mincey Marble to the jobsite without the material ever leaving the trailer and you pay for only the amount of space the crate occupies. Space is normally measured in linear feet. Shipping as partial freight is safer than shipping LTL as the order is not reloaded onto any other truck while en route and does not carry any crate size restrictions, unlike LTL.

A partial flatbed delivery requires a 5,000 lb capacity forklift with **minimum** 72" forks is required. A 5,000 lb capacity forklift with **minimum** 48" forks and a pallet jack will be necessary for materials delivered in a 53' van.

For all freight deliveries, the carrier will place a call to you after leaving our facility. A final courtesy call will be placed 24 hours before the material arrives to confirm the delivery date and approximate delivery time, allowing you the opportunity to procure the necessary equipment and manpower needed to unload. Upon the carrier's arrival, you have approximately 2 hours to offload.
