



Partial Shipment Delivery Information

When Mincey Marble has produced your order and it is ready for shipment, small and medium-sized crates will ship as partial truckload freight on a flatbed or enclosed van. This method is very beneficial because the shipment travels directly from Mincey Marble to the jobsite without being transferred between trucks, reducing handling and the risk of damage. With partial freight, you pay only for the space your crate(s) occupies on the trailer. In addition to being more cost-efficient, partial shipments are generally safer than LTL freight, as they are not reloaded at terminals along the way and are not subject to crate size limitations.

All partial flatbed deliveries require a 5,000 lb. capacity forklift with **minimum 72" forks** to be onsite at the time of delivery to unload the crated material. **All flatbed shipments containing shower doors require an 8,000 lb. capacity forklift with minimum 72" forks.**

All partial van deliveries require a 5,000 lb. capacity forklift with **minimum 48" forks and a pallet jack** to be onsite at the time of delivery to unload the crated material. **All partial van shipments containing shower doors require an 8,000 lb. capacity forklift with minimum 48" forks and a pallet jack.**
